

Postdoctoral position at the Universidad Complutense de Madrid

The Cardiac Cellular Electrophysiology Group at the Universidad Complutense de Madrid currently has a postdoctoral position open for candidates with doctoral degrees.

Our group has a strong background (more than 30 years) in cardiac cellular electrophysiology and is internationally recognized. Our research interests are focused in the analysis of the electrophysiological mechanisms underlying cardiac arrhythmias, especially atrial fibrillation. We are currently interested in the analysis of the regulation of ion channels by drugs, endogenous modulators, microRNAs and transcription factors. We use several electrophysiological and molecular biology techniques.

Candidates should possess a demonstrated background in the ion channel field.

The position is funded by a project within the Traslational Research Program of the Centro Nacional de Investigaciones Cardiovasculares and funding is available for a period of 3 years.
